



SCHEDULE OF FEES 2026: OVERSEAS STUDENTS

BUSINESS TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Enrolment of a student at Firbank is subject to the School's Business Terms and Conditions published on our website.

ENROLMENT FEES

An application to gain entry to the School must be accompanied by payment of a non-refundable application fee of \$200. When a student receives a definite offer of enrolment, a non-refundable, non-transferable enrolment fee of \$2,000 and an interest-free deposit of \$2,500 of tuition fees due is payable within 7 days (unless otherwise agreed).

TUITION FEES AND GOVERNMENT PAYROLL TAX RECOVERY SURCHARGE

Firbank's tuition fees include the costs of all compulsory excursions and the Alumni Life Membership fee for Year 12 students. A portion of the Victoria State Government Payroll Tax is recoverable from all students. Fees are payable in two instalments by 9th December 2025 and 31st March 2026.

SIBLING TUITION AND BOARDING FEES DISCOUNT (not applicable for ELC students)

2 nd child	10% of tuition and boarding fees
3 rd child	25% of tuition and boarding fees
4 th child	50% of tuition and boarding fees

JOINT SIBLING DISCOUNT WITH BRIGHTON GRAMMAR SCHOOL (not applicable for ELC students)

Upon receipt of a written application, a 5% tuition fee concession is available to students who also have a brother enrolled at Brighton Grammar School and are not receiving other fee assistance (e.g. scholarship or sibling concession) from Firbank Grammar School. This concession is not retrospective and only applies if fees are paid by the due dates above, or in accordance with an agreed payment schedule.

The School reserves the right to withdraw or vary the value of any concession at any time.

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES AND OTHER CHARGES

Whilst the tuition fees cover all compulsory activities there are some elective, co-curricular or voluntary activities, which attract additional charges. Co-curricular activities include elective camps, excursions and tours, specialist music tuition, rowing, netball, swimming, diving, tennis and snow sports. VCE fees will also be charged separately. The School reserves the right to prohibit a student from participating in optional excursions and activities where there is an outstanding account.

CHANGE OF VISA STATUS

Should a student be granted a local visa, any overseas fees paid in advance will revert to local student fees from the next full term upon receipt of a copy of the visa.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL FROM SCHOOL

One semester’s (two term’s) written notice of withdrawal to the Head of Campus is required. One semester’s (two term’s) tuition fee will be charged if insufficient notice is given. Please refer to the Business Terms and Conditions on our website for full details.

NOTICE OF WITHDRAWAL FROM BOARDING HOUSE

One semester’s (two term’s) written notice of withdrawal to the Head of Campus is required to avoid being liable for a further semester’s boarding fees. Please refer to the Business Terms and Conditions on our website for full details.

BILLING AND PAYMENT METHODS

A yearly invoice will be issued, and payment options are:

- A full year’s fees in advance - a discount of 2% is offered on tuition and boarding fees if full payment of all fees is received by 28th November 2025.
- 2 equal instalments are due by 9th December 2025 and 31st March 2026.

LATE FEES AND OVERDUE ACCOUNTS

Where any fees are not paid by the due date specified on the invoice, a late fee of 15%pa of the outstanding amount will be charged to the account.
